

Portion of RTD light rail temporarily shut down for repair November 12-13

Regular service will resume Monday, November 14

DENVER - November 10, 2016 – As a part of the Regional Transportation District (RTD) ongoing State of Good Repair efforts to provide safe and reliable service for riders, RTD will be doing wire repairs on the track from the Southmoor Station to the Lincoln Station and the track from the Southmoor Station to the Nine Mile Station on Saturday, Nov. 12 through Sunday, Nov. 13. During that time, E Line and H Line service between those stations will be temporarily unavailable.

Bus shuttle service will be available to passengers at all of the impacted stations:

- Southmoor Station: H Line shuttles will board at Gate F. E Line shuttles will board at Gate A in the bus/transfer station.
- Dayton Station: H Line shuttles will board at traffic circle near station platform.
- Nine Mile Station: H Line shuttles will board at Gate A in the bus/train transfer station.
- Belleview Station: Northbound bus shuttles will board at Gate G, southbound bus shuttles will board at Gate H.
- Orchard Station: Northbound bus shuttles will board at Gate B, southbound bus shuttles will board at Gate H.
- Arapahoe Station: All shuttles will board at Gate F.
- Dry Creek Station: Northbound shuttles will board at Gate B, southbound shuttles will board at Gate A.
- County Line Station: All shuttles will board at Gate C.
- Lincoln Station: All shuttles will board at Gate D.

Passengers using the rail lines affected by the closure can expect delays and detours and should allow extra travel time to arrive at their destination. Rider alerts will be posted at all impacted stations, and RTD ambassadors will be on-site to help direct passengers.

This is the second weekend of light rail closures during the month of November for maintenance and repairs. On Nov. 19, there will be no E or H service between I-25·Broadway Station and Southmoor Station. On Nov. 20, there will be no C, D, E or H service from I-25·Broadway Station to Union Station or 30th·Downing Station.
