

University of Colorado A Line maintenance work happening in November

Routine maintenance might cause late night and early morning delays

DENVER (Nov. 6, 2016) – The Regional Transportation District (RTD) is currently conducting routine maintenance work on the overhead catenary system (OCS) along the University of Colorado A Line through December.

All work will be done between 11:30 p.m. and 4:15 a.m.*During those times, passengers should expect minor delays and allow extra travel time to arrive at their destinations.

Crews will be making adjustments and conducting inspections to ensure a smoother and more reliable commute. RTD expects to have this work completed prior to heading into winter months.
