AURARIA STATION QUICK FACTS

Station Description

Assessments of the Auraria West Station location considered sites along the existing Central Platte Valley line in the rail yards. Once it was determined that the West Corridor alignment could not meet the Central Platte Valley line in this area, the Regional Transportation District (RTD) shifted the station approximately 300 feet north from the existing Auraria West Station.

The design team and RTD continue to work through the coordination of changes and adjacent station planning efforts for the Auraria Station. Initial plans include a center platform for the West Corridor line to include a transfer plaza to the Central Corridor. There will be no provisions for bus or kiss-n-Ride access.

The Auraria West Station will be a two track, two side platform station.

Station Activity

The Auraria West Station is currently in operation as part of RTD's C-line. The 300-foot relocation and incorporation of West Corridor trains will increase station activity.

Parking

RTD is not identifying any parking spaces at this station.
